It is a simple process to follow. Simply enter the required information (previous club, new club, association and reason).

Step 1: An email will go to the previous club asking to approve or reject the transfer.

- If the club approves an email will get sent to the association to approve or reject.
- If the club rejects the player will be notified of this by email.

Step 2: An email will go to the association for approval.

- If approved the player will receive an email with the answer that the transfer is approved and completed.
- If rejected the player will be notified of this by email.

The player will need to make sure they have paid all fees etc before starting the process.
